(Base Year: 2004-05=100)

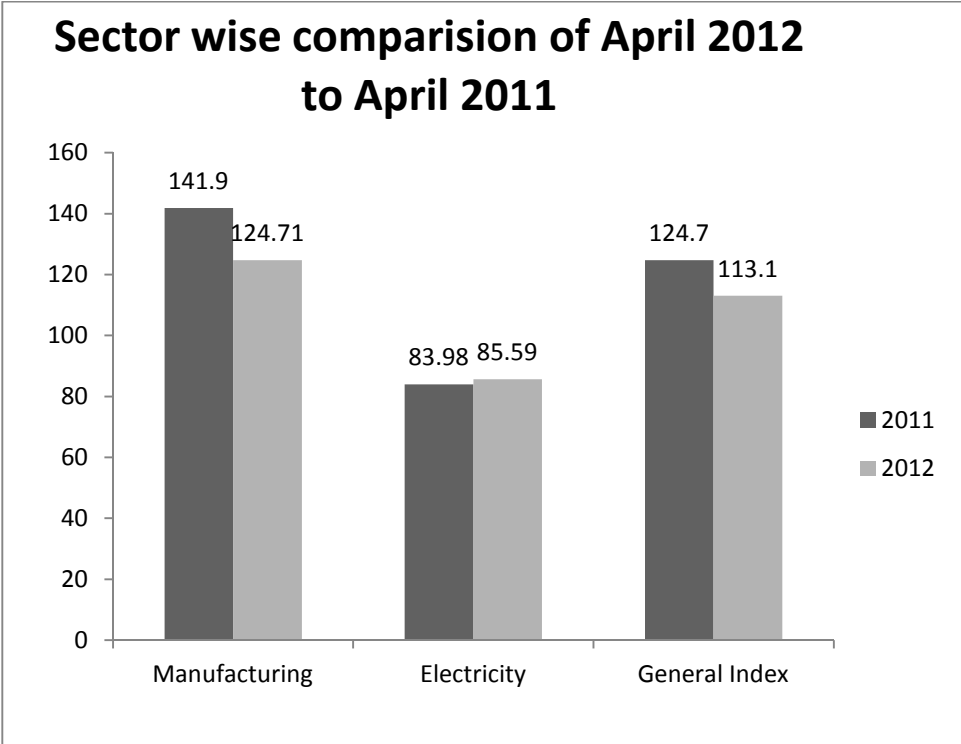
1.1 Directorate of Economics & Statistics, Govt. of NCT of Delhi compiles the Index of Industrial Production (IIP) for Delhi on monthly basis and releases on annual basis. The base year for the IIP is 2004-05 = 100. IIP is the short term indicator of the trend in organized manufacturing sector. In Delhi, the IIP is compiled on the basis of production data received from 270 industries comprising 268 manufacturing units and 2 electricity production units viz. NTPC, Badarpur and Indraprastha Power Generation Ltd. in respect of 105 items. For the purpose of compiling IIP, the industry sector has been divided into manufacturing and electricity sector. 70.31% weight has been assigned to manufacturing sector whereas electricity sector has assigned 29.69% weight. The manufacturing sector has been further divided into 20 major industrial groups at two digit level.

1.2 In previous years the IIP was being compiled on monthly basis but was released on yearly basis. During the last year i.e. 2011-12 the same was released on quarterly basis. Now it has been decided to release IIP on monthly basis from the year 2012-13. In this series the Index of Industrial Production for the month of April 2012 has been compiled. It was possible with the help of Web Application developed by DES to collect monthly production data from the selected units through on-line.

1.3 The IIP in Delhi has decreased from 124.7 in April, 2011 to 113.1 in April 2012 indicating a decline of 9.30%. During this month Production in manufacturing sector has declined from 141.9 to 124.71 i.e. by 12.11%. whereas Production in Electricity sector has increased during the month from 83.98 in April 2011 to 85.59 in April 2012 i.e. an increase of 1.92%.

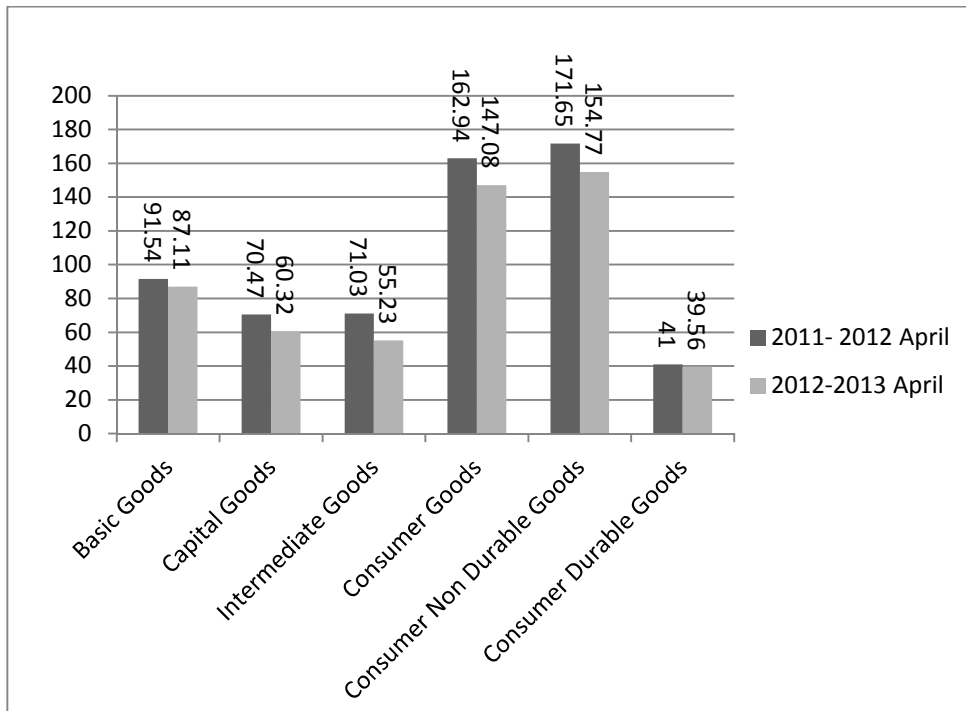


1.4 As per Use-based classification, the growth rate in April 2012 over April 2011 are (-) 4.84 % in Basic goods, (-) 14.40% in capital goods and (-) 22.24% in intermediate goods. The consumer non-durable and consumer durable goods have recorded negative growth of 9.83% and 3.50% respectively, with the overall decline in production of consumer goods by 9.73%.

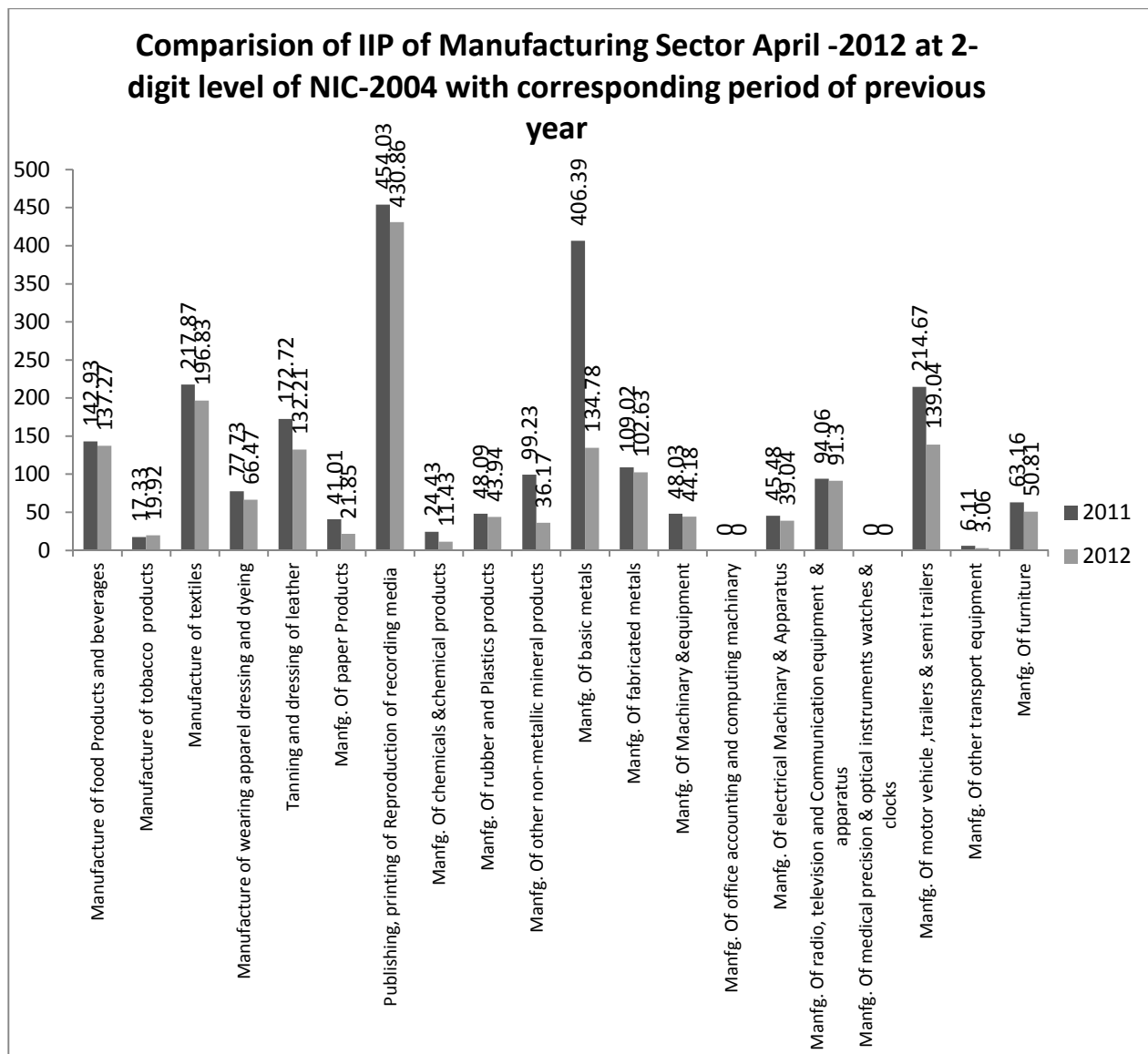
Comparison of Use Based Index

Main findings of the Index of industrial production are as under:

- (a) The Index of Industrial production in Delhi has decreased from 124.70 in April 2011 to 113.1 in April 2012 indicating a decline of 9.30%.
- (b) The IIP for manufacturing sector has decreased from 141.90 in corresponding month of previous year to 124.71 in 2012 indicating a decline of 12.11%.
- (c) The IIP for electricity sector has increased from 83.98 in April 2011 to 85.59 in the corresponding month of 2012 registering a growth of 1.92%.
- (d) Out of 20 Major groups (NIC 2 digit level) only one group viz. manufacture of tobacco products has shown positive growth in April.
- (e) The index of industry group ‘Manufacturing of basic metals’ has decreased from 406.39 in April 2011 to 134.78 in the corresponding month of 2012 registering a decline of 66.83%.

This decline has been observed due to decrease in production of copper coated wire, iron plates sheets and iron wire.

- (f) The index of industrial group manufacturing of other non-metallic mineral products has decreased from 99.23 in April 2011 to 36.17 in April 2012 indicating a decline of 63.55%. This decline is due to decrease in production of welding rods.
- (g) The index of industry group 'Manufacturing of Chemical and Chemical products' has declined from 24.43 in April 2011 to 11.43 in April 2012 indicating a decline of 53.21%. This negative growth is due to decrease in production of polio vaccines & flavored syrup.
- (h) The index of industry group 'Manufacture of other transport equipments' has decreased from 6.11 in April 2011 to 3.06 in April 2012 indicating a decline of 49.92%. This decline has been observed due to decrease in production of clutch plates
- (i) The Index of industry group 'Manufacturing of paper products has declined from 41.02 in April 2011 to 21.85 in April 2012 indicating a negative growth of 46.72% .This decline has been observed due to decreased production of corrugated boxes and greeting cards.
- (j) The index of industry group 'Manufacture of motor vehicle, trailer and semi-trailers' has decreased from 214.67 in April 2011 to 139.04 in April 2012 registering a negative growth of 35.23%. This negative growth has been observed due to decreased production of piston rings, motor vehicle parts and water pump assembly.
- (k) The index of industrial group tanning and dressing of leather, manufacturing of luggage, handbags & footwear has decreased from 172.72 in April 2011 to 132.21 in April 2012 indicating negative growth of 23.45%. This decrease is due to decreased production of footwear.
- (l) The index of industrial group 'Manufacture of wearing apparel, dressing and dying of fur' has decreased from 77.73 in April 2011 to 66.47 in the corresponding month of 2012 registering a decline of 14.49%. Decrease in production of garments is due to lack of export orders in this group.
- (m) The Index of industrial group 'Manufacturing of furniture and other mfg. n.e.c.' has decreased from 63.16 in April 2011 to 50.81 in April 2012 indicating a decline of 19.55%. This decline has been observed due to decrease in production of gold/silver ornaments / jewellery.
